



The canonization of Pier Giorgio Frassati will take place in 2025!

The official announcement was made by Cardinal Marcello Semeraro, prefect of the Dicastery for the Causes of Saints, during the 18th National Assembly of Italian Catholic Action, in Sacrofano, Italy. "I would like to tell you that **the canonization of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati** is now clear on the horizon and looming for the next jubilee year," he said. He was then interrupted by a long applause!

Please join in prayers of thanksgiving that this event we have prayed for is becoming a reality. How beautiful that this news came on the tenth anniversary of the canonization of Pope Saint John Paul II who beatified Pier Giorgio in 1990. As it is so often said, God's timing is perfect!

The canonization date has not yet been announced but we will keep you posted.



Building the Good Adventure

To date, we have received gifts totaling \$1.8 million, of which \$1,034,349 has been collected. *When paying your pledge, please write* **capital campaign** *in the memo of your check.*

Phase One of our Frassati Parish Campus includes an 12,340 square-foot facility for worship, fellowship, meetings, & offices, a 3,560 square-foot "ad alternate" middle school wing for Seton Catholic *pending their fundraising efforts* (picture below), vital infrastructure, parking, a storage and social ministries space, garden with columbarium, and prayer trails with Stations of the Cross & Way of the Beatitudes.



Moving Forward

"The Catholic Community of Carolina Forest (CCCF)" Facebook Group is rebranding into "Team Frassati" Facebook group. It will officially launch on May 18th, the 100-year anniversary of when Pier Giorgio began his youth club called the Tipi Loschi ("Shady Characters"). In collaboration with Christine Wohar and FrassatiUSA, "Team Frassati" will serve as the official online community for English speakers of all ages around the world who are devoted to Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati. Father David and Regina Vehige met with Christine Wohar April 24-26 to film original content for "Team Frassati". Our official Facebook page for the parish, "Pier Giorgio Frassati Catholic Church," will remain unchanged and will focus on what is explicitly happening within our parish's "one joy-filled family on the good adventure."

Father David and Paul Flood walked the property with Horry County on April 24th to assess the drainage situation of beavers continuing to build dams and the best pathway forward.
