



"I would like to tell you that **the canonization of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati** is now clear on the horizon and looming for the next jubilee year," he said. He was then interrupted by a long applause!

Please join in prayers of thanksgiving that this event we have prayed for is becoming a reality. How beautiful that this news came on the tenth anniversary of the canonization of Pope Saint John Paul II who beatified Pier Giorgio in 1990. As it is so often said, God's timing is perfect!

May future Saint Frassati intercede for you in a special way today and always!




