Announcements

The canonization of Pier Giorgio Frassati will take place in 2025!

The official announcement was made by Cardinal Marcello Semeraro, prefect of the Dicastery for the Causes of Saints, during the 18th National Assembly of Italian Catholic Action, in Sacrofano, Italy. "I would like to tell you that the canonization of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati is now clear on the horizon and looming for the next jubilee year," he said. He was then interrupted by a long applause!

Please join in prayers of thanksgiving that this event we have prayed for is becoming a reality. How beautiful that this news came on the tenth anniversary of the canonization of Pope Saint John Paul II who beatified Pier Giorgio in 1990. As it is so often said, God's timing is perfect!

The canonization date has not yet been announced but we will keep you posted.

Building the Good Adventure

Phase One of our Frassati Parish Campus includes an 12,340 square-foot facility for worship, fellowship, meetings, & offices, a 3,560 square-foot "ad alternate" middle school wing for Seton Catholic *pending their fundraising efforts* (website link below), vital infrastructure, parking, a storage and social ministries space, garden with columbarium, and prayer trails with Stations of the Cross & Way of the Beatitudes.

Moving Forward

Father David met with the Bishop and Diocesan officials in early May to stamp out the clauses of our historic property deal. Father David met with the Finance Council, Building Committee, and again with diocesan officials the last week of May to finalize our surest path forward for the next three years.
