

The official announcement was made by Cardinal Marcello Semeraro, prefect of the Dicastery for the Causes of Saints, during the 18th National Assembly of Italian Catholic Action, in Sacrofano, Italy. "I would like to tell you that **the canonization of Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati** is now clear on the horizon and looming for the next jubilee year," he said. He was then interrupted by a long applause!

Please join in prayers of thanksgiving that this event we have prayed for is becoming a reality. How beautiful that this news came on the tenth anniversary of the canonization of Pope Saint John Paul II who beatified Pier Giorgio in 1990. As it is so often said, God's timing is perfect!

# Building the Good Adventure

Phase One of our Frassati Parish Campus includes an 12,340 square-foot facility for worship, fellowship, meetings, & offices, a 3,560 square-foot "ad alternate" middle school wing for Seton Catholic *pending their fundraising efforts* (website link below), vital infrastructure, parking, a storage and social ministries space, garden with columbarium, and prayer trails with Stations of the Cross & Way of the Beatitudes.

# **Moving Forward**

Father David met with Frasssati's Building Committee and Boudreaux architects to review an estimate of the first phase of construction and to prioritize the various pieces to that for the sake of expediting the project.

Father David met with the Finance Council to approve the budget for the new fiscal year beginning July 1 and to approve a 3-year lease of a property off of Carolina Forest Blvd for office and meeting space. This space can house our current weekday liturgies and events and permit additional weekday events during the daytime, something currently impossible when the school is in session.

Father David met with Diocesan officials to finalize the clauses of the property deal and to stamp out a 3-year memorandum of understanding (MOU) for our rental of Seton School for weekend and holy day liturgies and major social events.

Father David met with parishioners (Mary Audino and Poppy Hepp) to discuss a parish/diocesan pilgrimage to Italy for the canonization of our patron (Pier Giorgio) next year.
