

Building the Good Adventure

Moving Forward

On June 11, Father David spent the evening speaking to friends (outside of Frassati parish) in the Myrtle Beach Deanery about our mission and vision and the need to grow our capital campaign fund further in order to build the first phase of our parish campus. He is seeking other parishes to adopt us as a "sister" parish and to provide financial support for our first project.

On June 12, Father David participated in a young adults "Following in the Footsteps of Frassati" pilgrimage meeting. The pilgrimage sponsored by a non-profit organization called Creatio takes place July 30 - August 7 in northern Italy. Eight young adults and Sister Marie Josèphe Webb from Our Lady Star of the Sea will be accompanying him.
