


Upcoming Events

As of July 1, all new employees and volunteers will need to create an account in VIRTUS® to complete the training and background screening. 

Building the Good Adventure

To date, we have received gifts totaling \$2.0 million, of which \$1,188,442 has been collected. *When paying your pledge, please write* **Capital Campaign** *in the memo of your check.*

Phase One of our Frassati Parish Campus includes a 12,340 square-foot facility for worship, fellowship, meetings, & offices, vital infrastructure, parking, a storage and social ministries space, garden with columbarium, and prayer trails with Stations of the Cross & Way of the Beatitudes. *Renderings are being updated without a middle school wing. Not building it will save us about \$1.5 million on the total project estimated at between \$8-9 million.* To date we have \$2,081,675 in savings and another \$800,000 pledged, which gets us to a total of \$3 million towards the \$8-9 million needed. <u>FrassatiChurch.org/Our-Future.html</u>

Moving Forward

Effective Monday, July 8 all Frassati weekday activities (Monday through Saturday morning) will be held at the Frassati Hub - our leased space at 215 Ronnie Ct, Unit B (the first street after the Post Office on Postal Way). This includes Adoration, Confession, Mass, discipleship events, prayer group meetings, business meetings, and staff meetings. We will even have limited office hours.

Our Holy Day of Obligation Masses (5:30pm) and Sunday liturgies (Saturday Vigil Mass at 4 pm, and Sunday Masses 8 am, 11 am, 5 pm and Confession times) will remain at Seton School, 1300 Carolina Forest Blvd.

Please make note of these changes. We are excited about having a temporary place to call home until we have our Frassati Parish Life Center up and open.
