Building the Good Adventure

To date, we have received gifts totaling \$2.0 million, of which \$1,235,427 has been collected. *When paying your pledge, please write **Capital Campaign** in the memo of your check.*

Phase One of our Frassati Parish Campus includes a 12,340 square-foot facility for worship, fellowship, meetings, & offices, vital infrastructure, parking, a storage and social ministries space, garden with columbarium, and prayer trails with Stations of the Cross & Way of the Beatitudes. *Renderings are being updated without a middle school wing. Not building it will save us about \$1.5 million on the total project estimated at between \$8-9 million.* To date we have \$2,128,560 in savings and another \$800,000 pledged, which gets us to a total of \$3 million towards the \$8-9 million needed. Moving Forward

On July 11, Father David met with the Frassati Building Committee and Boudreaux Architects to review the updated floor plan without the middle school wing to assess ways to simplify the project to expedite construction.

On July 15, Father David met with the Frassati Finance Council and Boudreaux Architects to review the budget for the first phase of constructing the Frassati Campus (Parish Life Center, Parking Lots, Frassati Garden with Columbarium, etc.). They strategized on how to begin the project in phases to keep construction moving as soon as it is okayed by Horry County and the Diocese.

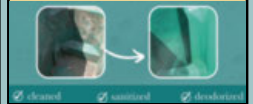
