



# Building the Good Adventure

To date, we have received gifts totaling \$2.0 million, of which \$1,243,512 has been collected. *When paying your pledge, please write* **Capital Campaign** *in the memo of your check.* 

Phase One of our Frassati Parish Campus includes a 12,340 square-foot facility for worship, fellowship, meetings, & offices, vital infrastructure, parking, a storage and social ministries space, garden with columbarium, and prayer trails with Stations of the Cross & Way of the Beatitudes. *Renderings are being updated without a middle school wing. Not building it will save us about \$1.5 million on the total project estimated at between \$8-9 million.* To date we have \$2,136,646 in savings and another \$800,000 pledged, which gets us to a total of \$3 million towards the \$8-9 million needed. <u>FrassatiChurch.org/Our-Future.html</u>

# **Moving Forward**

We have a number of personnel and committee additions and changes moving forward for Frassati to announce.

Carol Schembari is stepping back from overseeing Friends of Frassati (all social and outreach ministries) to focus on serving within the ministries themselves and helping more with outreach to the Newman Center at CCU. We are very grateful for everything she has done the past year overseeing these ministries and Safe Environment for the parish!

Mary Audino will assume the role of Director of Friends of Frassati, working with the ministry heads and being a bridge to the Stewardship Council that is entasked with helping with recruitment and instilling our mission and vision in the ministries. She will also be the head of Safe Environment as the Diocese transitions to the usage of Virtus, an online ("paperless") vetting process for those serving in various capacities in the parish. Mary is team leader for an auditing team at Bank of America and is excited to be able to use those skills for the parish.

Soon the parish will have a part-time receptionist at the Frassati Hub. As a "first responder", this person will also help with other parish and office projects. Normal office hours for the Frassati Hub will be Monday/Wednesday/Friday 10:00 am - 2:00 pm. The anticipated start date is Monday, August 5.

Since our inception we have begun several councils/committees at Frassati. The Finance Council is the only one required by canon law. The Diocese of Charleston requires that half of the members of the Finance Council have 3 year appointments and the other half 2 year. We will adopt this strategy for several of our other councils in order to keep a flow of new ideas and freshness in leadership.

**The Finance Council:** Mike Hagg, former President of HTC is chairman (3 year), Monica Vehige, CEO of McLeod Health Care (3 year), Ed Duffy, former executive for Exxon Mobil (2 year), Cheryl Mathieu, former insurance executive and current executive director of Horry County Literacy Council (2 year). The two year terms will end February 6, 2025 - the second anniversary of our foundation as a parish.

**The Tithing Committee:** Sally Markus as bookkeeper for the parish (no limit), Monica Vehige as Finance Council representative (3 year), Phyllis Philips (3 year), Debi Perry (2 year), Joe Martin (2 year). These terms will stay in sync with the Finance Council's and the 2 year terms will end February 6, 2025.

**The Stewardship Council:** Regina Vehige (chairwoman as head of Mission Advancement), Mary Audino (Director of Friends of Frassati), Rob St. Peter (2 year), Deb Sentz (2 year), Dawn Marie Roudybush (3 year), and, recently added, Kathy DeLucia (3 year). These 2 year terms will end on July 1, 2026.

The Building Committee will not have term limits. Membership is based upon the project(s) at hand. Currently, it's membership includes: Paul Flood (Chairman and co-owner of Strand Metal Service), Larry Flood (co-owner of Strand Metal Service and Deanery Representative for the Diocesan Building and Renovation Advisory Committee), Tom O'Donnell (former residential builder and chairman for building of the Newman Center at CCU), Bob Schaetzl (former high voltage lineman and working foreman), Jared Roudybush (residential builder and former code enforcement for Horry County), and, recently added, Jessel Elliott (structural engineer).


